Restoring the American middle class. To do this we must create more manufacturing jobs. The average U.S. manufacturing worker earns \$77,060. The average worker earned \$56,436. Union employees earn an average of \$23,000 more than non-union employees. Union apprenticeships prepare 450,000 workers for high skill, high paying jobs each year. Colleges have crushed America's youth under \$1.2 trillion in student loan debt, without teaching them the skills necessary to succeed. My top priority will be removing legal barriers to allowing workers to organize into labor unions.
