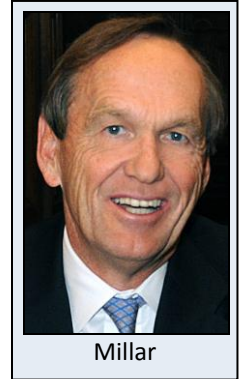


**NAME: Fran Millar**
